The critical events and associated timelines are as follows:

November 1, 2009 – New Unison with Smart Charger products are available for sale (including new remote head assembly) as well as all existing Unison product models.

January 1, 2010 – The existing 6 & 12 VDC, 36 thru 72 watt Unison models go obsolete. The existing 6 VDC, 12 thru 25 watt Unison series becomes available with limited product options.
